Story with pictures



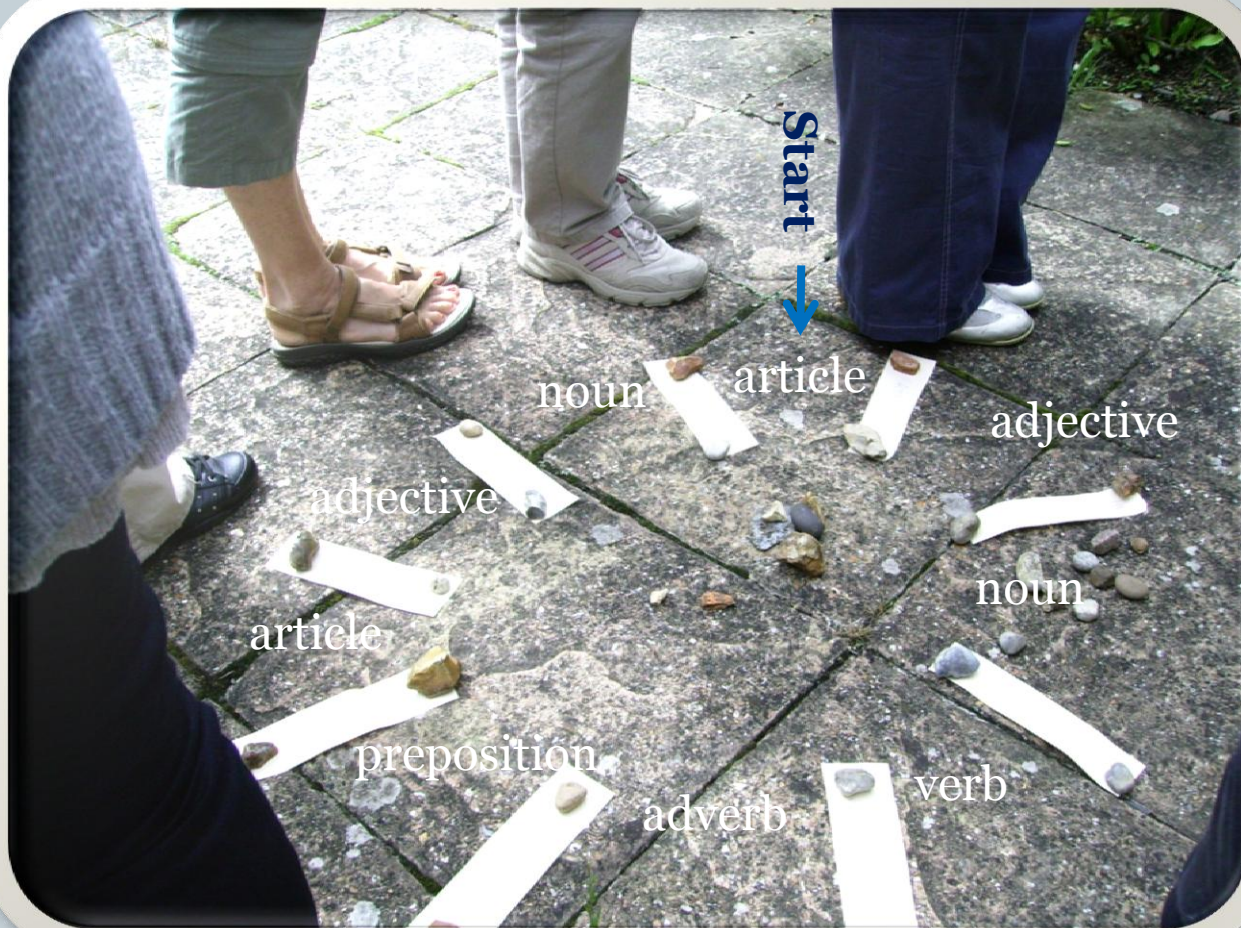
1. Create a story.

6. Tell the story.
7. Change the pictures and tell the story again!

Make a toy



1. In groups look at the different toys carefully (one group – one toy).
2. Write down an instruction how to make the toy.
3. Share the instructions. Don't show the toys to others!
4. Make a toy according to the instruction.
5. Compare the toys!

Sentence on the ground



1. Write down the names of parts of speech - each on different piece of paper.
2. Turn on the music (or sing a song). Go around. Stop when the music stops.
3. One by one say a word – make a sentence.
4. Start it again!
